Metal

METAL

- Aluminum Cans
- Tin cans
- Pie tins (rinsed)
- Clean aluminum foil
- Empty aerosol cans (remove caps)
- Small metal items (bottle caps, bolts, nails, etc.) place inside a metal can & crimp it shut

- Office paper (all colors and weights)
- Newspaper, Magazines and catalogs
- Phone books
- Mail
- Egg cartons
- Aseptic cartons (soups, juice boxes, soy milk, etc.)
- Gable-top cartons (such as milk cartons)
- Cardboard tubes
- Cardboard boxes, flattened*

*If your business has a separate dumpster for cardboard, flatten all boxes and put in the dumpster.

Plastic bottles & tubs

- Plastic bottles of all sizes and types, caps removed
- Milk jugs, caps removed
- Plastic tubs 6 oz. to 5 gallons, lids removed
- Plant containers—4 inches and larger, cleaned



WHAT ABOUT ...

Glass VIDRIO

- Glass bottles and jars of all colors and sizes go all together in your separate GLASS ONLY blue bin or roll cart. Remove any metal or plastic lids.

- Frozen food boxes—wax coated
- Bubble wrap
- Styrofoam
- Plastic wrap/bags—(Return to retail)
